Reception in Jeddah

On May 19, 2023, the Syrian President, Bashar Al Assad, was received in Jeddah by the Secretary-General of the Arab League and prominent Saudi officials as he arrived to head his country's delegation to the Arab Summit for the first time in more than 12 years.

Latest Updates

Jeddah declaration

It welcomed the decision to resume the participation of Syrian delegations in the League Council meetings, while Al Assad stressed on the principle of non-intervention in nations' internal affairs but rather to leave it up to the people to settle their disputes.
